The Match Committee reserves the right to alter these competition specifications during the season in any way it sees necessary to ensure the completion of competition events. Any changes will be notified to all clubs prior to closing dates for entries to competitions.

- Please remember that the Match Committee works on a voluntary basis and operates around other commitments, please be patient, & leave a message on phone when appropriate, so that you can be contacted when the Convenor is available.

Suggestions or Submissions for Consideration for Next Season

The Sub Centre Executive and the Match committee are always interested in constructive ideas for future seasons. Please submit any such suggestions in writing to the Match Committee Convenor at the end of the season and prior to the Annual General Meeting of the Sub Centre.

Laws and Regulations

All competitions will be played in accordance with the **Laws of the Sports of Bowls**, Crystal Mark Fourth Edition effective from 1st April 2023 & Bowls New Zealand regulations as applicable.

Adhesive markings

If adhesive discs are used, all bowls belonging to players within a team or side should have the same **design and colour** adhesive markings.

Cancellations

The Match Committee Convenor, or Tournament Controller, will advise Clubs/Players entered in a competition/fixture if the competition/fixture is postponed or cancelled.

Inclement Weather

- **For Sub Centre events all players should report to greens as scheduled.**
- **Play in Sub Centre competitions may be subject to a delayed start in preference to either postponement or cancellation**
- **The Sub Centre Match Convenor, or their appointed representative, shall be responsible for decisions on the start of play, postponement, or cancellation of events.**
- **The Sub Centre Match Convenor will consult with green keepers at scheduled venues regarding the use of the greens whenever an event is affected by inclement weather.**

Cell Phones

The use of cell phones is not permitted by players on or alongside the greens during play. It is preferred that all cell phones are switched off or are on silent during play.

Draws

Draws for all Competitions and Tournaments will be published on Bowlshub in the week before the competition is due to be held. In addition to this clubs will also be emailed a Bowlshub Link to access draw information.

Sub Centre Titles

All these events, except for Champion of Champion events, require that qualifying rounds be played followed by one life knockout to find the winner to qualify for a Sub Centre title.

All rounds may be played in one day & must have a minimum of 12 people or teams to be eligible for a title.

The following events qualify for a Sub Centre title:

- **Senior & Junior Champion of Champion events**
- **Men's Open Singles – J Lowry Cup**
- **Women's Open Singes – Nan Marsh Trophy**
- **Sub Centre A\C Pairs 242**
- **Sub Centre Triples**
- **Junior Singles**

Players winning a total of five Sub Centre titles will qualify for the award of a Sub Centre Star, **Silver Star** for Open events & a **white Star** for the Junior events.

Dress Code

The dress code for all Mid Canterbury Sub Centre fixtures and events is Club Uniforms, unless otherwise stated on entry forms.

Controlling Body

The controlling body for Sub Centre events is the Bowls Mid Canterbury Sub Centre Match Committee. The controlling body will have the right to alter, add to, or delete any conditions of play due to unfavourable weather and/or special conditions to enable the completion of a competition/fixture. Each competition /fixture will be under the control of a Tournament Controller appointed by the Match Committee.

Entries

- All entries for the Mid Canterbury Sub Centre Events must be submitted through Bowlshub Aotearoa or given to the Sub Centre Bowlshub administrators to be entered on your behalf.
- Entries that are being submitted to Sub Centre administrators must be completed on the forms provided in this booklet and must contain full details as required on the form this includes all valid Bowlshub IDs of all team members.
- **Entries are to be Submitted onto Bowlshub Aotearoa by the specified closing date and time late entries are only accepted at the discretion of the Sub Centre Match Committee.**
- Any entry submitted on an incomplete format (e.g., without names of team members or Bowlshub id numbers) may not be accepted.
- Interclub & Champion of Champion event entry fees will be invoiced to clubs by the Sub Centre Treasurer
- Individual event entry fees are to be paid by entrants as a bank transfer into the account number **03-1354-0596221-01** this number is also on the entry forms, please enter a Name & Event as reference on transfer.
- Any withdrawal of a player or team from a competition must be notified to the Match Convenor ASAP.

Plural Membership

- A player, who is a full-playing member of more than one club in the Sub Centre, can now play for any club she/he is a member of in any competition.
- Plural members can play in any one discipline at one club only. E.g., they can only play Singles at **One** club, there is no restriction on them playing singles at one club and pairs at another, or any combination of disciplines as required so long as they play each discipline at **One** club only—note also that this rule shall apply to substitutions.
- **Score Cards**
- The skip shall be responsible for the scorecard in all disciplines.
- The scorecard must be completed **clearly and in full** for every game.
- The names of all players and the time the game finished must be entered, and the scorecard must be signed by both skips.
- A completed and signed score card shall be the official and final record of any game or match.

Results

Recorders will be provided with appropriate cards/sheets/forms to complete for each competition round. Instructions will be given with appropriate forms and should be followed. It is important that the results are accurate. All teams should send in results regardless of home or away, win or lose.

Umpires

Umpires are organised for each Sub Centre competition held at Club Greens in consultation with the Mid Canterbury Bowling Umpires Association. Clubs must provide an umpire or a competent neutral person to officiate on Interclub days.

Clubs are encouraged to ensure that they have at least one qualified Umpire in their membership, and more if possible.

Substitutes Players.

Law 32 and Bowls New Zealand Regulation 2 shall apply in all situations.

A Substitute is a player who is either temporary or permanently replacing an absentee member during a game or tournament.

Substitutes shall be permitted in accordance with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls:

(Crystal Mark 4th Edition April 2023), and Bowls New Zealand Regulations.

For Champion of Champion Events clubs wishing to apply to use a substitute player must do so in writing on the approved form as contained in this booklet.

Application for a substitute player should be made as soon as the need for a Substitute is known and must be in the hands of the Match Committee no later than one hour before play is due to commence. Clubs may phone Tournament Convenor in advance of an event to notify the intention to present a replacement player application prior to the start of play in an event.

Applications from Clubs will be considered for the following reasons: accident, illness, family bereavement, work commitments. Other individual exceptional circumstances may be considered for approval at the discretion of the controlling body but must be consistent with Bowls NZ regulations.

The Match Committee, as the Controlling Body for Champion of Champion Events, will decide on the eligibility of any substitute or replacement player prior to the commencement of a competition, and notify the Club/Player of their decision.

Failure to provide written application for a replacement player as required prior to any competition commencing will result in disqualification from participation in that competition.

Where a player qualifies for a National/Centre or Sub Centre event that are scheduled to be played on the same day, a replacement player shall be allowed, except for Singles events.

Trial Ends

Before the scheduled start of play in any game, or before continuing an unfinished game on another day, one trial end may be played in each direction.

Trial ends must be completed not less than 5 minutes before the scheduled start of play.

Refer to Law 5.1 in Laws of the Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark 4th Edition April 2023.

Club Controlling Bodies may arrange play in all Club Championships as they desire for the number of shots in Singles or ends in Pairs, Triples & Fours. Qualification for entry is that in Club Championships either open or drawn entries qualify, any members may form a pair, triple or a four.

- The Team members who win the Club Championship must be the members who are nominated & entered in the Sub Centre Champion of Champion Competition.
- Any change in playing personnel shall be subject to the prior approval of the Sub Centre Controlling Body and shall be limited to one substitute player, in accordance with Law 33 and Bowls New Zealand Regulation 7.

The Club entry must be competition based unless a club has insufficient members to hold a competition.

- Where a club has insufficient members to hold a competition & sufficient player to make up a team, the club may nominate the members to make up their Champion of Champion competition entry.

General Conditions

- It will be Men & Women for ALL Senior Champion of Champion events & for the Junior Singles Champion of Champion Events.
- All other Junior events including Pairs, Triples & Fours will be A\C as of the 2024 AGM. Clubs will only be eligible to enter **one** team into the Champion of Champion Yr1/2 Pairs & Junior Pairs, Triples & Fours.
- Junior Yr1/2 and Junior Singles remain as separate Men's & Women's events.
- Where a game is of a fixed number of ends, in the event of a tie, an extra end or ends shall be played to decide the winner.
- No time limit.
- Byes will be disposed of in the first round.

Junior Events:

- Junior Events are for players who have been full playing members of a club and are in their 5th playing year or less.
- Where a Club has sufficient **Registered** players that qualify as Junior's or Year 1-2, to enable a competition to be played, a competition **must** be played to make an entry into Champion of Champion events.
- Where a club has only one qualifying Junior or a year 1-2 player the club may nominate this player for entry into the Sub Centre Champion of Champion Junior or Year 1-2 Singles event.
- Junior & 1–2-year competitions will now be any Combination (excluding Singles which will stay as a Men's & Women's separate events) so each club can only have 1 team in each event for the COC e.g. Fours, Triples, Pairs (not Men's & Women's separate events).
- For Yr 1/2 Singles – there will be separate competitions for Men and Women UNLESS there are less than 2 entries in either grade, in this case the competition will be combined into one event.

Standard Conditions of Play
Mid-Canterbury Sub-Centre J8 Super Singles

Games

- Singles - 3 bowls per player.
- Games of 2 sets of 6 ends with a 1 end tiebreaker if the score is one set each or two drawn sets.

Per game

- 3 players per rink, 2 playing & 1 marking Each person plays 2 games and marks 1 per night.
- You can visit the head after your 2nd Bowl making sure you are past the head before your bowl comes to rest.

Mat and jack placement

- 1 mat used per game (**please carry the mat**)
- The winner of the toss for a game may give away the mat if he or she chooses too, the winner of the first set starts the second set & Tie breakers will get a coin toss the winner can give away the mat away if he or she chooses too.
- The Jack always starts on the 2-metre mark mat placement chosen by winner of the previous end.
- If possible, have 2 jacks per rink, 1 at each end of rink or send jack for marker to place.
- Any kills **not nominated** get re-spotted on the 2-metre mark.

Power play and nominated kill

- 1 **powerplay** per player per set (**any scored shots are doubled**).
- 1 **nominated kill** per player per set (**End replayed if jack killed**).
